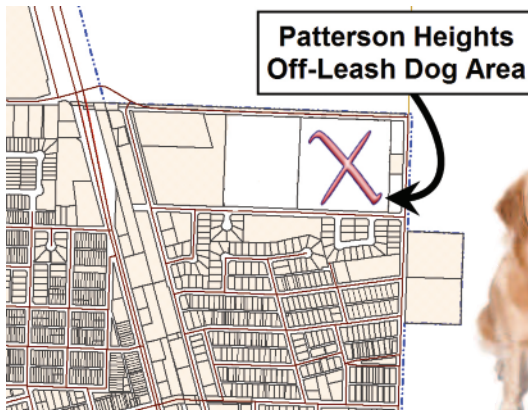

• On the westside of Town the area lies east of 8th St West, west of Willow Road and south of Westover Avenue. This area does not include the park east of Willow Road.



• The newly constructed Kin Trail (west of 8th St) and the storm pond paths are not considered off leash dog areas. **Please be respectful and pick up after your dog in ALL parks and paths, even off leash areas.**
