## COVID-19 Winter Entry Plan As of October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**Face coverings (masks) are required for all participants entering the facility, exceptions for swimmers 8 years and under and those with medical exemptions.**

**Swimmers must come with swimwear under their clothes.**

### **New Entry Point**

- 2 doors east of the Hot tub Entry, enter at the green double Fire Doors with the ramps.
- Please follow Alberta Health physical distancing guidance.
- Screening protocol with temperature checks upon entry.

### **Program Entry- Be prompt**

- Doors open just before the start of the program, and are closed with no outside access after the last patron enters the facility. Lifeguards are required on deck.

### **Hallway Protocol**

- Footwear can be placed on shelves in pool hallway.
- Clothing hooks will be available for jackets, these are limited. There are bags available upon entry if needed.
- All participants will go through the Family Change room to the pool deck.

### **Deck & Pre-Shower**

- Face covering can be removed.
- Participants proceed to marked areas/pods to remove clothing.
- Swimmers rinse in Family Room Shower before entering pool.

### **End of Program & Exit**

- Swimmers proceed to change rooms to change
  - Rinse if needed, this is not a full shower. Staff are required to clean before the next group enters the facility, please be timely \*10 minutes max
- Exit through the doors you entered from

### **Payment**

- Can be made prior to the swim by Etransfer to [payments@claresholm.ca](mailto:payments@claresholm.ca), please mark in notes what the payment is for
- Can be made on deck after your swim time, on your way to the change rooms
