PURSUANT to sections 230, 606 and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Claresholm in the Province of Alberta has given first reading to Bylaw No.1651, which on final passage would amend the Town of Claresholm Land Use Bylaw No.1525.

THE PURPOSE of proposed Bylaw No. 1651 is to accommodate cannabis related uses in the land use bylaw No. 1525 in accordance with Federal and Provincial legislation.
