

COVID-19

Measures in Claresholm

As a result of announcements made by the Alberta Government and the Chief Medical Officer of Health on December 8, 2020 to be in effect until at least January 12, 2021.

Effective December 13, 2020:

- Town of Claresholm Administration Office will be closed to the public.
 - In-person visits will be on a case-by-case basis by appointment only.
 - Staff will be available by phone or email during regular business hours.
 - Payments continue to be accepted through your bank, by mail to Box 1000, online banking or by e-transfer to payments@claresholm.ca.
 - Cheques or documentation will be accepted through the mail slot at the main entrance.
- Claresholm & District FCSS office will be closed to the public.
 - Staff will be available by phone or email during regular business hours.
- Claresholm Arena will be closed to the public.
- Claresholm Aquatic Centre will be closed to the public.
- Claresholm Public Library will be closed to the public.

Remaining closed to the public:

- Claresholm Curling Rink
- Claresholm Seniors Drop-in Centre
- Claresholm Community Centre

These measures are being taken to ensure that the Town of Claresholm is doing all we can to help bend the curve of COVID-19 infections in our community and our province.

Province Wide Measures Effective December 8, 2020

- All indoor and outdoor social gatherings are prohibited. This will be enforced with \$1,000 fines.
- Masks are mandatory in all indoor public spaces and workplaces.
- All out-of-town travel is discouraged.
- Maximum of 10 people for wedding ceremonies or funeral services and must be held in a public place. Receptions are not permitted.
